"All of humanity's problems stem from man's inability to sit quietly in a room alone." ~ Blaise Pascal, 1654

A few months ago, I watched a film called "Sound of Metal". The film was, in a nutshell, about a young man who discovers he is losing his hearing. He is a drummer in a heavy metal rock band and as such, subject to extreme volumes. On the surface it reads simply as the audience going along with

"Ruben" (played by Riz Ahmed) as he reels from this sudden loss and seeks to get it fixed. But the film truly goes deeper than that.

I believe its underlying message is that nothing is wrong with Ruben. There is nothing to fix. Being whole in the world is not the same as being whole in Christ.

Ruben's character seeks to resume the life he had before, a life that has been wholly broken and without a path. He researches surgical solutions to what he sees as his loss. At the prompting of his girlfriend, he stays for a while in a community specializing in addicts who are deaf which clashes with his desire to 'fix' himself. While there, he is challenged to sit quietly and seek stillness, which is, God's Kingdom. I will not spoil the film but, in the end, Ruben finally sees himself as God sees him. Whole, unique and, fashioned "according to His love and wisdom" and not in need of fixing.

This abundant generosity of God was shown to us yet again this Christmas through an unbelievably generous financial donation to Next Step by the Knights of Columbus Council 676. Next Step had applied for a grant through the Knights of Columbus for a new ultrasound machine. Our ultrasound machine was outdated, and we now have two sonographers performing ultrasounds, and two nurses in training to do ultrasounds as well, so the need for a new machine was apparent. The Knights of Columbus not only covered the cost of the new machine, but also surprised us with a financial donation that none of us could believe!



Thanks to this donation we have been able to hire our second nurse (who was previously a volunteer while training to do ultrasounds) as a Next Step staff member. As we move forward with two nurses on staff, we are excited to soon be offering more frequent ultrasounds and to be able to perform them when needed for abortion vulnerable women. Also, thanks to their donation we can begin preparing to do STD/STI testing for our clients in the not-too-distant future.

Praise God for His endless generosity which we have seen and still see in so many ways in our lives and here at Next Step!

Prenatal Care Fund

We are excited to announce the approval of the Next Step Prenatal Care Fund. Many of our clients who come in needing insurance for prenatal care qualify for Apple Health through the state. But what about those Moms who do not? It is a terrible feeling to tell someone (who may be working 2 or more jobs) "Sorry, you work too hard." Or "You just make too much money." While rare, there are times when our clients make just beyond the state's threshold for insurance. If it is not open enrollment season (typically November/December) these women cannot receive coverage for vital prenatal care (including 2nd trimester diagnostic ultrasounds, glucose tolerance testing for gestational diabetes, urine tests for preeclampsia and other necessary tests). All expenses must be paid for out of pocket. We are so blessed to now have a fund specifically designed to help clients in this unique situation. Those who are taking initiative to do their absolute best for their children no longer need to be denied services because of their superior work ethic.

You may be wondering about how this story ties in with Next Step Pregnancy Services and our mission to show the humanity of unborn children and to protect and defend their lives.



In a 2012 Prenatal Diagnosis article (obgyn.onlinelibrary.wiley.com, 14 March 2012) "their research calculated a weighted mean across the U.S. of a 67% termination rate following prenatal diagnoses of Downs Syndrome"

In other words, the possibility of giving birth to a baby with this "defect" was enough for many expectant parents to decide to terminate rather than welcome their perfect child into the world. That is a very staggering number to me. That well over half those children are snuffed out before ever being able to have dreams, have families, have experiences, have birthdays, have love – is a tremendous and wholly avoidable loss.

They are not damaged, disabled, and in need of fixing. Those who would see them as disposable are the ones who are truly broken. Next Step's mission is to speak for and defend those in need, within the womb and without.
